Coronavirus Infection Prevention

Clean and disinfect shared work spaces and high-contact surfaces with an approved EPA Disinfectant.

Stay home if you experience any cold-like symptoms.

LEMON DISINFECTANT

- Clean surface of heavy soils if necessary
- Apply undiluted to surfaces
- Must remain wet for 10 minutes
- Wipe dry or allow to air dry
- Rinse surfaces that contact food



GOLDEN TOUCH HAND SANITIZER

- For use when soap and water are not available.
- Place enough on hands to cover all surfaces and rub together until dry.
